We will...

- Deliver a sustainable provision for children of key workers as well as those who have been identified as being exceptionally vulnerable, whilst ensuring the health and wellbeing of everyone.
- Maintain contact with those learners who are not attending school, providing ideas, activities, resources for learners and their families. Teachers and tutors will tailor support and learning packages to their specific requirements.
- Work collaboratively with other agencies to ensure that learners and families receive the support they need.

In order to reduce the risk of infection, Greenside has introduced an alternative provision known as “Greenside COVID-19” (G-19) Our revised curriculum requires less planning and can be offered by a wider range of staff. The focus is...

Social distancing

In order to enable “social distancing,” we will ensure that the number of staff and learners on site is kept to a minimum through the use of a rota. G-19 runs from 10.15 to 2.15. Class staff work from 10 - 2.30
G-19 requires a minimum of 1x first aider; 1 x SLT; 1 x DSP

Expectations of staff who are not in school

Throughout the period that our usual school provision is suspended, teachers and tutors who are well and not required to be in school, will work from home during their usual contracted hours. They will prepare learning for those who are at home and undertake school projects. Where possible training opportunities will be provided for all staff.
