## A<mark>ctivities</mark> with torches

- Turn off the lights and dance with finger torches and ribbon.
- Make coloured telescopes using cardboard tubes, coloured cellophane and elastic bands. Try using bits of bubble wrap too.
- Make shapes with wire and use a torch to create Shadow Sculptures, try using sheets of coloured paper as backgrounds and take pictures.
- Using tin foil and a tray, pour/drip water over the foil. shine the torch on water and foil.
- Use different coloured cellophane to put over end of torch and explore. Try shining through the bubble wrap.
- Build a cave, using chairs, sheets and blankets, shine torches inside. Try using the foil blancket for this.
- Blow bubbles in the dark and shine torches through them.

## Activities with household objects

- Using what's around, make the longest line you can through your home. Imagine it's the Great Wall of China!
  - Make a sculpture using forks and spoons take pictures.
  - Make a city using packets and tins from the kitchen cupboards
- The floor is lava! Using cushions, squares of paper etc... move around the room without touching the floor.
- Don't let the balloon touch the floor.
- Cover a tray or work surface with flour and use it to draw in.
- Fill a bowl with water, drop in different objects to see what floats and what sinks.

Make a spider's web under the table, or around the room using a ball of wool.
